Hoover High School Graduation 2024 Information Packet



Commencement Protocol

Commencement is a serious and solemn occasion. It is a special and important night not only for you, but it is extremely important for your family and friends. You owe it to yourself, your family, and Hoover High School to be at your very best and to conduct yourself with dignity. Please remember that graduation is a dignified occasion. *We want to make this event special for you, your family and friends. Please dress and act according to the guidelines outlined below*.

Location/Arrival Time:

- Hoover High School commencement will be held Tuesday, June 4th, at the Save Mart Center at 8pm
- Seniors should plan to arrive at the Save Mart Center no later than 6:15pm
- Doors open at 7:00PM for spectators

Things to Remember:

- Cap, gown, and tassel
- Wear cap straight and not tilted on your head.
- Tassel should be worn on the **right side** until after diplomas have been awarded and you are given the instruction to turn them.
- Cultural Stoles can be worn but must be under your Hoover stole

Personal Belongings:

• Purses, cameras, sunglasses, and bags cannot be carried in the processional. Leave these items with someone who will be attending your graduation. Personal items cannot be left backstage.

Posture and Manners:

This is an honor. Please act with the utmost respect for the ceremony and those who have worked hard for you to participate.

- Walk proper.
- Sit up straight in your seat.
- Do not talk during the processional, recessional or at your seat at any time during the commencement ceremony.
- Do not chew gum.
- No whistling, yelling, waving or any other type of distraction.
- Nothing should be added to your cap or gown.
- Save Mart Center Security will search all graduates; this is Save Mart Center policy.
- Take the diploma in the left hand; shake hands with your right hand.

Unacceptable Behaviors:

- Screaming or calling out remarks, side comments, and nicknames.
- Disrupting the graduation ceremony by passing around, displaying, or inflating objects such as signs, beach balls, pictures, or any other object.
- Physical displays such as cartwheels, flips, peace signs, dancing etc.
- Using any type of noise making device such as air horns, bells etc.
- Any behavior or mode of dress deemed disruptive or distracting from the graduation ceremony.

Any person engaging in behavior that is unacceptable will be removed from the Save Mart Center by security personnel.

Graduation Attire Recommendations

Appropriate Attire:

- Dress, skirt, dress pants, or slacks
- Dress shirt with collar, button shirt
- Ties or bow tie with button ups
- Your dress or skirt should not be longer than the graduation gown
- Dress heals, dress sandals, or dress shoes, dress socks
- No tennis shoes, athletic sandals, or flip flops
- No jeans
- No corsages
- Tie (optional but highly recommended)

Nothing should be added to your cap or gown.

After receiving your diploma cover, DO NOT throw your cap.

Remember graduation is a privilege not a right.

Please respect all those who have worked hard, including each other, for this day!


Prohibited Spectator Items at Graduation Venues

In order to provide a safe and secure environment for all, the following items are not permitted in any of the Fresno Unified Graduation Ceremonies, but not limited to:

- Posters
- Bottles, cans, coolers, or similar items
- Food, drinks, or illegal substances
- Any weapon, including chains and/or studded bracelets
- Video equipment, professional cameras, tripods or recording devices
- Laser pointers, aerosol cans, noisemakers, and/or fireworks
- Backpacks, unwrapped gifts, bags larger than 4.5" x 6.5" or 6.5" x 4.5", clear plastic bags larger than 12" x 6" x 12", boxes
- Umbrellas
- Helium balloons
- Smoking, including e-cigarettes or vapors
- Lighters of any kind

- Selfie sticks
- Pets or non-service animals
 Any other items determined to be
- unacceptable or dangerous by management
- Explosives
- Guns
- Stun guns
 Handcuffs
- Brass knuckles
- Sticks
- Clubs
- Batons
- Martial arts instruments
- Pepper spray
- Tear gas
- Knives with blades over 2" in length

BAG POLICY



ONE CLEAR BAG THAT DOES NOT EXCEED 12" x 12" x 6"

OR

ONE (1) NON-CLEAR SMALL CLUTCH THAT DOES NOT EXCEED 4.5" x 6.5" x 2"

An exception will be made for any necessary medical items, but all such items are subject to inspection prior to entry into Save Mart Center.

Parking:

Save Mart Center will only accept debit/credit cards. NO CASH.

Graduation Walking Partners

Seniors have the option of selecting their own walking partner for graduation. Walking partners enter, sit, and exit together. In order to make the color of gowns visually appealing, there are options with your walking partner. **Option A:** You pick a partner with the opposite color gown from you. If you're in white; your partner is in green. You will be seated in the front rows. **Option B:** You pick a partner with the same color gown as you. If you're in green; your partner is in green. You will be seated towards the back half rows. If a student does not select a partner, a partner will be selected for them. There will be no empty seats.

SENIORS, CHOOSE WISELY; THERE WILL BE NO REARRANGING OF PARTNERS AFTER THE INITIAL MATCHING HAS BEEN COMPLETED. You will choose your partner and your actual GRADUATION SEAT on June 1st.

Graduation Tryouts

National Anthem:

A valedictorian speech is given by a valedictorian. Student must try out and be selected to give speech. There will also be a senior speech at graduation. This is open to all graduating seniors. Processional Teachers

There are 26 teachers that get to help lead the graduates onto the graduation floor for the graduation ceremony. The teachers wear a gown, walk in front of a group of students, and sit in the rows with the students. You get to nominate which teachers you would like to be on the floor with you for graduation! Think back to ALL FOUR YEARS of your high school experience and the teachers that have impacted your experience. Scan the QR code to nominate teachers.

Senior Check Out

Friday, May 24th, 2024

Seniors will receive a check out form and have until Friday, May 24th, to get all teachers signatures, financial window, and library signatures. Seniors will need to return items to library and pay any necessary bills.

On Friday, May 24th, students will be required to formally check out in the cafeteria. Once students have checked out and all bills are paid, students will take their completed form to their counselor, located in the cafeteria, for final clearance. Caps and gowns will then be available for pick up. **The check out process will be after school. Students must go to ALL classes on May 24th.**

- 1. I, ______, do agree to abide by the following items of this Senior Contract for the duration of my senior year, specifically as it relates to any and all senior activities, including commencement.
- 2. I will return or make payment for all library books, textbooks, equipment and athletic uniforms/equipment by senior check out.
- 3. I understand that my conduct may jeopardize my ability to participate in senior activities and my graduation ceremony.
 - A. If I receive an off campus suspension from school in the second semester I will receive an official notification.
 - B. If I receive a second off campus suspensions offense, I may **NOT** be allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony.
 - C. If I receive and off campus suspension within the last 20 school attendance days, I may be denied the privilege of participating in the graduation ceremony, even if that off campus suspension is my first off campus suspension during my senior year.
 - D. After senior check- out, but before the graduation ceremony, if I engage in behavior that is inappropriate and would be considered a suspendable offense, I may NOT be allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony.
- 4. I will abide by all school policies, rules and regulations as stated in this High School's Student Handbook. This includes ALL STUDENT ACTIVITIES on and off campus. I realize that failure to comply with all school rules and policies may affect my participating in graduation commencement and senior activities
- 5. I will fulfill all academic requirements for a diploma or certificate of completion. Satisfactory progress in all courses must be maintained to participate in senior activities. I understand that I may not be allowed to participate in the graduation commencement ceremony and/or receive a diploma or certificate of completion until all requirements are met.
- 6. I will attend school on a consistent basis. Confirmed truancies will affect my grade and place me at risk of not graduating. Truancies will result in being placed on the "NON-PARTICIPATION" list for school sponsored activities including senior activities and the graduation commencement ceremony.
- 7. I will attend commencement practice. If I do not attend commencement practice, without prior approval by an Administrator, I will not be allowed to participate in the graduation commencement ceremony.
- 8. I understand senior pranks will not be tolerated and, if I participate in a senior prank, I jeopardize the privilege of participating in the senior activities, including the graduation commencement ceremony.
- 9. Prior to denial of the privilege of graduation, the student, and their parent/guardian, shall be made aware of the grounds for such denial and shall be given an opportunity to respond. If a privilege of participation in the graduation ceremony is to be denied, the student and parent/guardian shall receive notice of the denied privilege and the means whereby they may appeal the decision.
